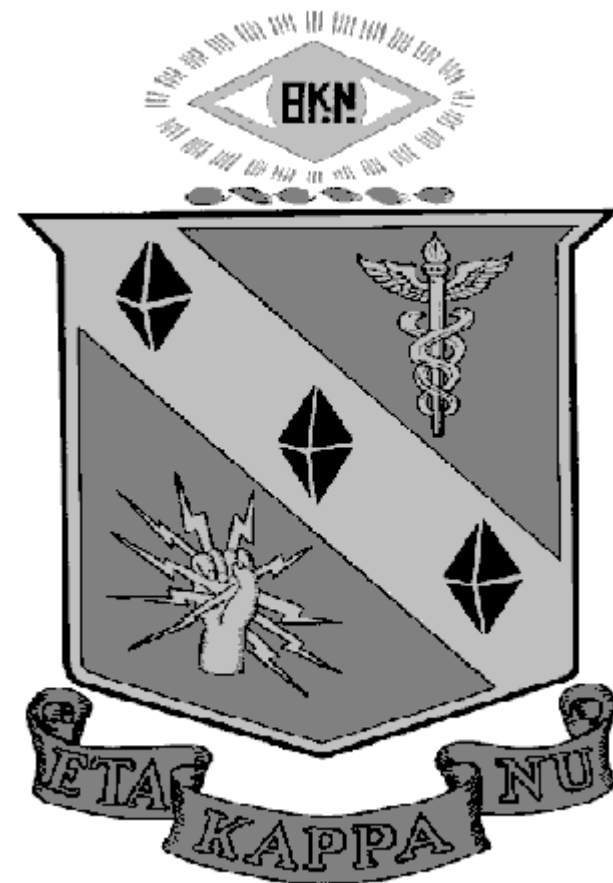


Preamble to the Eta Kappa Nu Constitution
