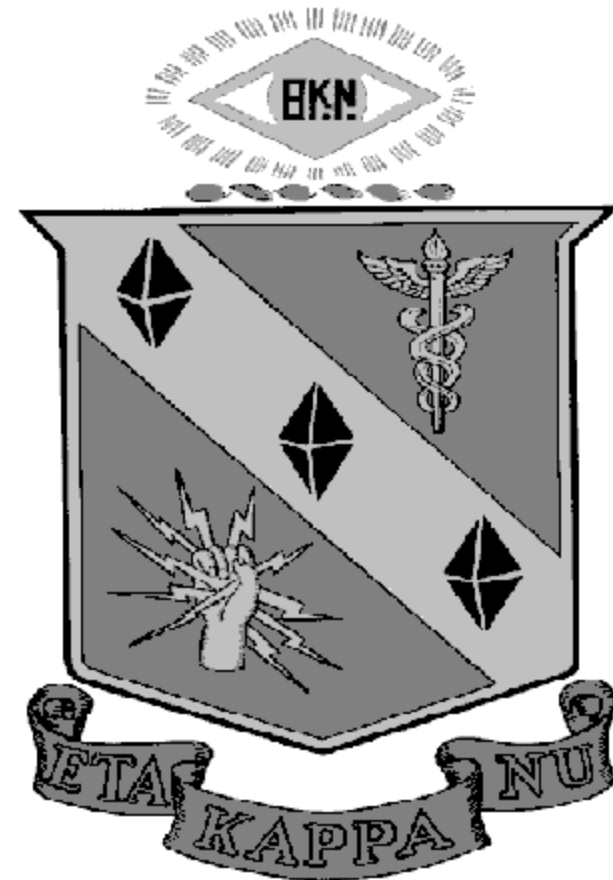


Preamble of the Eta Kappa Nu Constitution
